# **ARRIVAL AND ACCOMMODATION IN ROME**

For Covid related purposes, delegates of each House are kindly requested to communicate as soon as possible to the Secretariat of the Italian Chamber of Deputies, **by 29 September** at the latest, their travel plans, the hotel chosen and the contact details of a delegation focal point for each House, by sending an email to <u>protocol.romecop26@camera.it</u> using this <u>form</u> per each Delegation. A WhatsApp group will be created and focal points will be included after communicating their phone numbers.

### LANGUAGES

As previously communicated, interpretation will be provided in **five languages** (Arabic, English, Italian, French and Spanish). Speakers addressing the Meeting in any other language will need to have their individual statements translated into one of these five languages.

A number of booths on a first-come-first-served basis will be available for delegations bringing their own interpreters. Delegations wishing to have an interpretation booth and bring their own interpreters are kindly requested to inform the Italian Secretariat at the following email address: <u>interpreti@camera.it</u> by 29 September.

# **REQUESTS FOR THE FLOOR**

Given the large number of participants and in order to offer all Delegations the possibility to make a contribution, in principle only one Delegate per House of Parliament will be able to take the floor once during the whole meeting. Participants wishing to take the floor should be registered at the following email address: <u>romecop26@camera.it</u> **by 29 September.** Kindly indicate two Sessions, in order of priority, first and last name, country and relevant House of Parliament, using this <u>form</u>. Speaking time will be limited to **2 minutes**. A speakers' list will be distributed in due course.

In order to facilitate interpretation, speakers are kindly requested to forward their written speeches to interpreti@camera.it. Texts will remain embargoed and checked upon delivery.

#### **BILATERAL MEETINGS**

A limited number of rooms will be made available for **bilateral meetings** at the Italian Chamber of Deputies on a first-come-first-served basis. Booking requests should be sent to the Italian Secretariat at radoni s@camera.it by 29 September. In compliance with the anti-Covid measures in force at the Chamber of Deputies, a maximum number of 10 people per room will be allowed. Meetings may last no longer than 30 minutes in order to sanitise the rooms between meetings. Each delegation may reserve a maximum of two meetings per day. Slots will be available as follows:

- Friday, 8 October: 1.30 pm / 2.15 pm / 4.30 pm / 5.15 pm / 6.00 pm
- Saturday, 9 October: 2.00 pm / 2.45 pm / 3.30 pm / 4.15 pm / 5.00 p.m.

Confirmation of the slots reserved will be sent in due course.







# **CULTURAL EVENT AND MEALS**

For MPs only (including registered accompanying interpreters), the Italian Parliament will organize, in the <u>evening of 8 October</u>, a visit of the exhibition "Cosmowomen. Places as Constellations" and a dinner in the evening of 8 October, at the National Gallery of Modern Art.

A light lunch, for all Delegates, on 9 October will follow the Papal Audience, at palazzo Montecitorio, just before resumption of proceedings (scheduled at 2 pm).

You are kindly requested to confirm your participation and communicate any dietary restrictions by 29 **September** to the following email address: <u>protocol.romecop26@camera.it</u>, by using the same form used for travel and accommodation.

#### **PRACTICAL INFORMATION FOR THE MEDIA**

Journalists and camera operators are kindly requested to apply for accreditation by **29 September** (two journalists per media outlet) by sending their accreditation request to <u>sg\_ufficiostampa@camera.it</u> or <u>sg\_portavoce@camera.it</u>. Dedicated areas will be available to journalists on the floor of Palazzo Montecitorio where the Plenary Hall is located. Stand-up positions and interview points will be made available, to be shared among all the press and media people for the requirements of TV broadcasters and websites. All media operators will be submitted to an antigenic swab according to the rules explained under the following point "health information".

The proceedings of the Rome meeting will be streamed live on the WebTV channel of the Chamber of Deputies. A selection of photos will be uploaded to the dedicated website on a daily basis during conference proceedings.

#### **PAPAL AUDIENCE**

The Papal Audience in Paul VI Audience Hall is scheduled at 11.30 am on 9 October 2021 and will be preceded by a visit of St. Peter's Basilica (10 am -11 am). All registered delegates are kindly invited to arrive at Montecitorio at 9 a.m. on 9 October for the bus transfer to the Vatican.

Access to the Vatican will only be possible with transportation organised by the Chamber of Deputies.

#### **HEALTH INFORMATION**

Delegates travelling to Italy must present a COVID-19 molecular test (PCR) certificate showing a negative result. Under current Italian law, the test must have been carried out 48 hours before arrival in Italy.

Please note that all delegates travelling to Italy are required to complete a Passenger Locator Form (PLF) through the dedicated EUdPLF application. You can fill in the "Temporary Address" line by entering the code: **Camera dei deputati-COP26**.

Delegates coming from countries with entry restrictions to Italy for Covid-19 will not be subject to such entry restrictions, provided that they are officially registered to participate in the Conference, for the time necessary to attend the official event. The official list of registered participants will be published on the IPU website by 30 September.

Upon arrival at Leonardo da Vinci - Fiumicino Airport, delegates from non-EU countries and delegates not in possession of an EU Digital COVID Certificate (also known as the "Green Pass"), issued in compliance with current EU rules, will be asked to submit to an antigenic swab at a designated area inside the airport. If the swab test yields a positive result indicating the presence of SARS-CoV-2, the person testing positive will be consigned to the care of the competent health authorities.

The transfer of delegates from the airport to the city **shall be** by taxi, hire car or private vehicle. The use of a filtering mask (at least FFP2 type) is mandatory for the whole duration of transfers.







Without distinction, everyone participating in activities taking place on the premises of the Chamber of Deputies will be asked before the start of proceedings to undergo an antigenic (rapid) swab test at facilities set up for the purpose.

Exceptions will be made only for those who have taken the test on the previous day (7 October) at the Senate of the Republic, where the Seventh G20 Speakers' Conference will be taking place. The result of a swab test remains valid for 48 hours, after which delegates will be asked to submit to another swab test, which may be carried out at the Chamber of Deputies.

The swab tests will be carried out on 8 and 9 October 2021. Three testing centres will be set up, two of them in the parking lot of Via della Missione and one at No. 25 Piazza del Parlamento.

Each delegation will be assigned to just one designated testing centre, as shown in the table published on the website.

Swabs can be booked via the site: https://covidtest.camera.it. Bookings for the Covid-19 test can be made from 10 a.m. on Monday 4th until 12 noon on Thursday 7th October.

Instructions on how to book via the site can be obtained by sending an information request to infocovid@camera.it.

Testing on **8 October** has been divided into four time slots:

- 8 a.m. 10 a.m.
- 10 a.m. 12 p.m.
- 12 p.m. 2 p.m.
- 3 p.m. onwards

Tests are carried out on a first-come-first-served basis within each time slot.

On **9 October**, the test centres will remain open and operational for the entire duration of the conference proceedings, and no formalities are required of those wishing to take a test.

Any **cases of positivity** to SARS-CoV-2 will be handled by the health personnel in charge of the test centres. In particular, anyone who tests positive from an antigenic swab will be required to submit immediately to a molecular PCR test, and will be brought to a facility where they must remain pending the outcome of this second test. If the result of the second test confirms positivity to the virus, the person concerned will be consigned to the care of the competent health authorities.

After taking an antigen swab test, delegates with negative results will be given a personal badge and will be allowed access to the premises of the Chamber of Deputies. All delegates must also submit to the thermal screening of their body temperature. Anyone whose body temperature exceeds 37.5 degrees centigrade will not be allowed to enter the premises of the Chamber of Deputies.

All delegates will be given an **FFP2 mask**, which can be used for eight hours before disposal. The use of this mask as well as social distancing are mandatory for the entire duration of the meeting, social events included.

Finally, all delegates are urged to take out a specific insurance policy against the risks of SARS-CoV-2 infection.
